About IHDC

IHDC was founded in 1987 as an interfaith partnership dedicated to alleviating the problems of homelessness and the lack of affordable housing in Bucks County. Our mission is to provide housing via lease, lease-purchase, and direct-sale programs to low-income and homeless families as they work to become self-sufficient. IHDC works toward its mission by rehabilitating blighted homes

and occasionally building new ones, and then makes these homes available to its local client families. IHDC also hosts the Fresh Start Donation Center, which collects donations of gently-used furniture and household goods and redistributes them to families rebuilding their households after recently struggling with homelessness.
